

# WEBER COUNTY LIBRARY SYSTEM

## *Board of Trustees*

### SURPLUS PROPERTY SALE

---

The Weber County Library Board of Trustees accepts the responsibility for pricing Library discards and surplus materials sold to the public as provided in Utah law and County ordinance. The Board delegates to the Library Director the authority to establish prices and procedures to appropriately handle the sale, salvage, trade, donation, or disposal of specialized county property, including library books and materials. In no case shall the cost of disposal exceed the value of the items as determined by the best judgement of the Library Director.

Discards are those items formerly part of the Library materials collection. All Library discards and surplus property items that are sold will be disposed of in accordance with Utah Code, 17-50-312 and appropriate County ordinance.

Donated books and other items, that is, those items that have never been part of the Library System collection, but which have been evaluated under the direction of the Library Director, may be sold at public sale with the proceeds going to the Friends of the Library in support of Friends programs.
