NOTIFICATIONS YOUR WAY

Sign up and receive email or phone reminders when items are ready for pickup as well as overdue alerts.



SYSTEM-WIDE BORROWING

Borrow and request materials from any Weber County Library location; return materials to any location.



COOPERATIVE BORROWING

Free borrowing privileges with partner libraries in Davis, Morgan, and Summit Counties (excluding Park City), Brigham City, and Logan City.

MANAGE YOUR ACCOUNT

- » Visit weberpl.org and click **MY ACCOUNT** on the top right
- » **LOG IN** using your card number (located on the back of your card) and your PIN
- » **FORGOT YOUR PIN?** Reset it online or bring your library card and picture ID to any location for staff assistance

RENEW ITEMS

You may renew materials as long as they are not overdue or on hold for someone else. To renew:

- » Bring your items to any Weber County Library location, **OR:**
- » Access your account online and select the **RENEW** option, **OR:**
- » **CALL ANY LOCATION;** have your library card and item barcodes ready

CARDHOLDER RESPONSIBILITIES

- » Ages 18 and older are responsible for materials checked out on their card
- » Parents and guardians are responsible for materials checked out by those under age 18
- » Report all losses and/or damages
- » Make prompt payment of any charges
- » Provide prompt notification of any change of address or personal information
- » Provide immediate notification of lost or stolen card

WE CHARGE FOR DAMAGED ITEMS

Enjoy the Library's collections, but return them in good condition. Help us protect your investment by **reporting damaged items to staff at checkout.**

NOTE: All borrowing privileges will be suspended until overdue fines and bills are **below \$4.00**. Read the accompanying Library Board's Circulation Policy before using your card.

CURBSIDE PICKUP

1. PLACE HOLDS

Place items on hold at your library location.

2. CALL YOUR LIBRARY

Call your library location to confirm your holds are ready. Let staff know when you'll arrive for pickup.

3. PICK UP

Use designated curbside pickup parking and call the posted phone number. **REMEMBER:** have your library card number ready.
